PARDUBICE

Pardubice, with nearly 100,000 inhabitants, is one of the ten largest cities in the Czech Republic, 100 km east of the capital Prague. The city, first mentioned in 1295, went through a rich and exciting history which has left many traces on it. The Old Town and the Castle, built in a unique blend of Late Gothic and Early Renaissance styles by the Pernstejn Family in the 16th century, are surrounded by green parks and blue rivers. The Perstejn Palace, the church of St. Bartolomew and the 60 m high Green Tower in the town centre as well as the baroque Old Town square, the historical town hall and other picturesque sights in Pardubice are popular with tourists.

PARDUBICE INDUSTRY

The city is famous for its traditional products as gingerbread and beer but nowadays it is well known particularly for its chemical products, electronics and machine-tool production. Electronics has been developing in Pardubice since 1919 when the Telegrafia company, producer of telephone exchanges, sets and radio receivers was founded here. Presently a broad range of electronic products as communication systems, radar and microwave devices are both designed and manufactured in local companies.

UNIVERSITY OF PARDUBICE

The beginning of the University of Pardubice is connected with the year 1950 when the Institute of Chemical Technology was established to meet the needs of the East-Bohemian region which had a highly developed chemical industry. The University of Pardubice today offers modern study programmes at its four faculties (Jan Perner Faculty of Transport, Faculty of Chemical Technology, Faculty of Economics and Administration, Faculty of Humanities) and two institutes.

Please, do not number pages! The page number should be pencilled on the top right corner of the rear page.

Margins: left and right - 2 cm, top and bottom - 3 cm.

The header on the first page consists of (see above):

- Title of the paper (in capital letters)
- Names of the authors and their affiliation
- Short abstract (max. five lines single spacing)

The final size of the Conference Proceedings is A5. Please keep that in mind while using text and graphic signs in figures and graphs.

PAPER PREPARATION

The text should be typed in single column format on one side of the paper, left and right justified. Use single spacing in the body of the text and double spacing between sections.

Header/footer: The use of header/footer or footnotes is not

recommended.

All numerical expressions should be numbered; numbers indicated in

Figure captions should be below the figures; table captions should be above the tables. Paste figures using "Paste special..." and "Picture".
